SERVICES PROVIDED

- Early reading and writing skills
- Kindergarten readiness
- Free bus transportation in selected areas *(Other transportation services available on an individual basis to/from agency events.)*
- Health (vision and hearing) and nutrition screenings
- Disabilities services
- Nutritious meals and snacks
- Daily tooth brushing
- Family activities

Serving Children Birth to Five Years Old

Georgia Head Start and Early Head Start programs provide comprehensive early childhood and family development services to children from birth to five-years-old, pregnant women and families. Head Start services are responsive and appropriate to each child's and family's developmental, ethnic, cultural, and linguistic heritage and experience.

ELIGIBILITY

- *Children in foster care are categorically eligible.*
- *Family Preservation cases are subject to income requirements for eligibility.*
